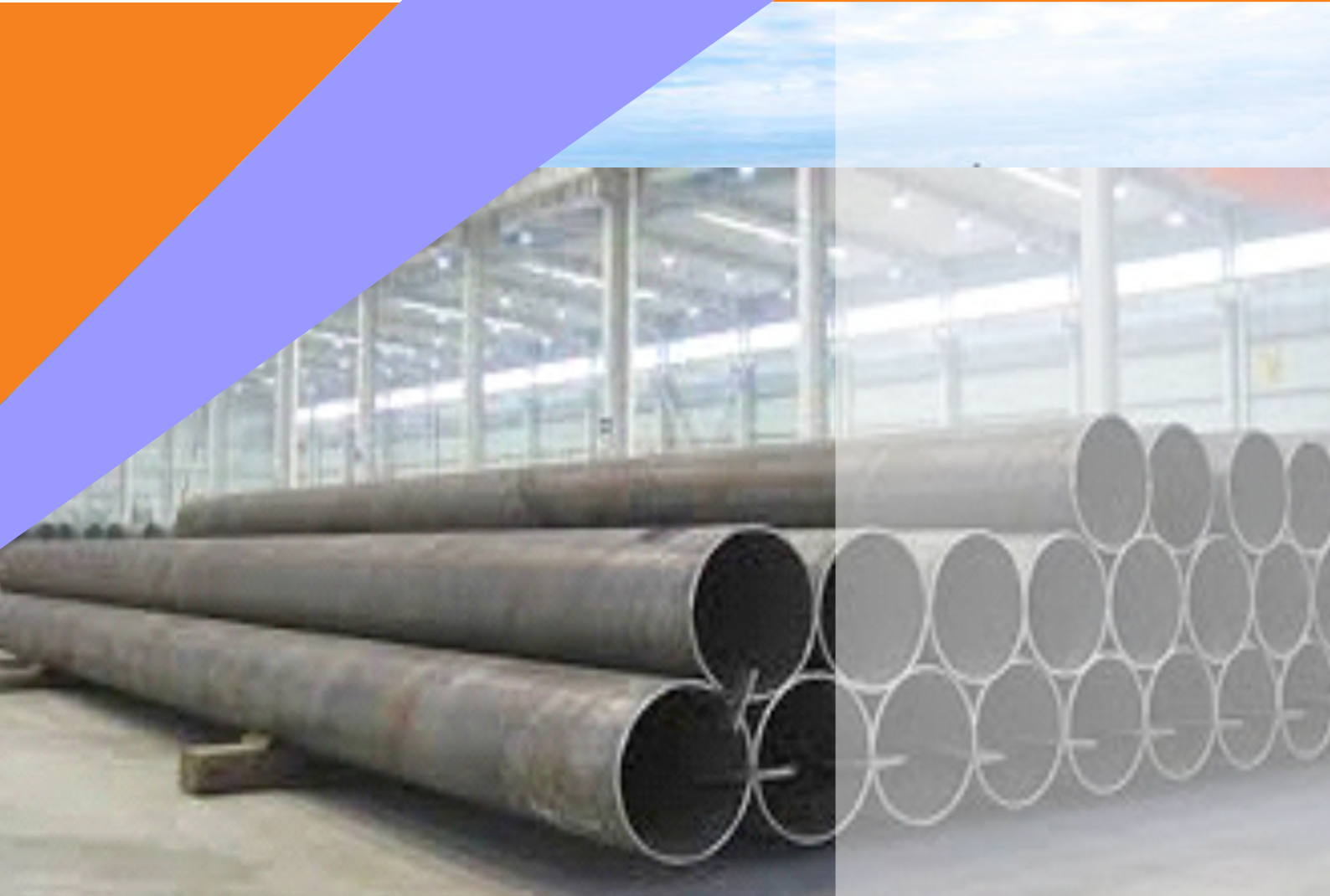

TERMINATIONS



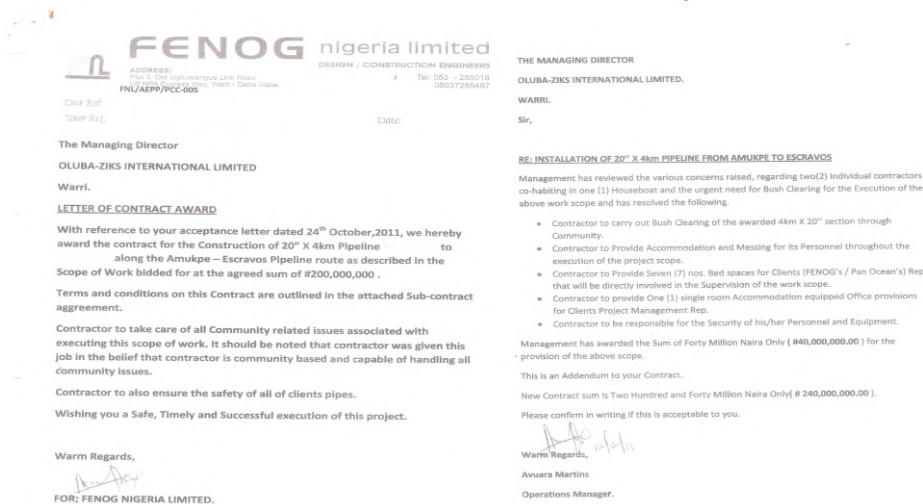

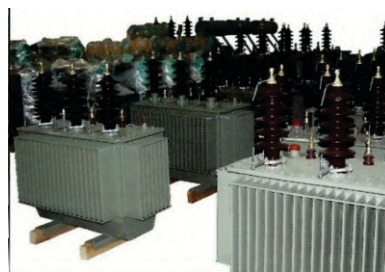
